## **ENDEAVOURS OF K.S.V.S.S.**

### **HEALTH PROGRAMME:**

#### **☞ Mother & Child Health Care :**

With a view to develop the health status of mother and children belonging to the poor and backward families, KSVSS has organized 2 (two) Mother & Child Health Care Camp in its area during the year. Doctors and other distinguished persons attended the camp and discussed on Health & Hygiene, breast feeding, family planning, infant care, safe maternity, nutrition etc. among the rural women and pregnant mothers to benefit them.

#### **☞ Blood Donation Camp:**

The objective of this programme is to save the lives of dying patients belonging to the poor families and to enhance universal brotherhood which is very needed in the present days of terrorism, blow and counter blow between the relatives, murder etc. The Society organized a blood donation camp at Vivekananda Training centre, Kapasaria on 19.07.2021 where 22 youths and women donated their blood to repay their social debt for the wellbeing of the common people. Medical officers from Subdivision Hospital and Basulia Rural Hospital were present.

#### **☞ World AIDS Day Celebration:**

KSVSS has arranged for celebration of World AIDS Day on 01.12.2020 to aware about the dreaded disease AIDS, a menace to the human society. Awareness and education on AIDS is urgently necessary for all adult and youths to save our people from this disease. The school and college students, Panchayat members and NGO workers attended this programme where Dr Mohanlal Ghorai, Medical Officer, Basulia Hospital, , social workers were present as resource persons.

#### **☞ Dengue Fever & Malaria :**

The society has arranged awareness camp on Dengue Fever was organized at Kapasaria Sub Health Centre, Kapasaria under Itamogra II Gram Panchayat, Mahishadal Block, Purba Medinipur. Dr. Mohanlal Ghorai, BMOH, Basulia Rural Hospital, Mahishadal Block, Mrs. Sampa Kanp, Pradhan, Itamogra II Gram Panchayat, Mr. Madhusudam Maiti, Secretary, Kapasaria Sarbik Village Service Society, Asha Karmi, attended as resource persons and discussed on Dengue fever as well as the preventive measures among the participants.

#### **☞ Adolescence Awareness Camp :**

With a view to aware the rural people especially rural women the society has organized Adolescence Awareness Camp in its area. Adolescence is usually associated with the teenage years, but its physical, psychological or cultural expressions may begin earlier and end later. For example, puberty now typically begins during pre-adolescence, particularly in females. Physical growth (particularly in males) and cognitive development can extend into the early twenties. It is a period of multiple transitions involving education, training, employment, and unemployment, as well as transitions from one living circumstance to another. Doctor, social workers attended the camp and delivered lectures of the subject so that the rural people can handle their children in the age of adolescence period. 42 people participated in the camp and benefitted.

#### **☞ NATIONAL CRECHE PROGRAMME :**

3 Crèche centres sponsored by Director of ICDS Scheme ( West Bengal ) / the West Bengal Social Welfare Board, are being run by this society in the villages of (i) Kapasaria, (ii) Bamunia & (iii) Masuria under Mahishadal Block of Purba Medinipur district. 75(25 x 3) children (Male 38 and Female 37) under 6 years of age of 3 units are being provided with nutritious food, medical checkup by part time doctor and emergency medicines, Playing arrangement, preschool education, bedding facilities and elementary

education etc. Monthly Meeting with Village Level Committee, Mothers Meeting, Home Visit are also maintained by the crèche workers and Crèche helpers as per Covid-19 Guidelines by Govt. of India and WB Govt.

#### ☞ **Child Labour & Trafficking:**

KSVSS is a member of *Block Level Child Protection Committee* (ICPS) under Mahishdal Block . Members and Volunteers of the society conduct awareness programme on child Labour & Trafficking satisfactorily. To combat the trafficking of girls and women in the area, the KSVSS organized one seminar on trafficking where resource persons like govt. officials, social workers etc. attended and delivered lectures on the subjects. All the participants requested to alert about the child/ women trafficking racket in the area. 46 participants took part in this seminar.

### **CAMPS & SEMINARS**

#### ☞ **Water Conservation:**

One of the items people, animals, and our environment cannot live without is water. Water is extremely vital in the everyday life of everyone in the world from everyday life of drinking, washing clothes, animals, grains, cleaning, and so many other uses that eliminating water would eliminate our species as we all depend on the necessity of water. KSVSS conducted one awareness camp on Water Conservation at Kapasaria in Mahishadal block area. Environmental experts, doctors, panchayat leaders and social workers attended these camps and delivered their lectures on the need of water conservation. Various measures for conservation of rain water were discussed among the participants.

#### ☞ **Entrepreneurs Development Programme for Coir Industry:**

Three days Entrepreneurs Development Programme was organized by Coir Board, Ministry of MS & ME Govt. of India at Kapasaria from 09<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2021 in Association with Kapasaria Sarbik Village Service Society, on development on Coir Industry in our area. Mr. Jomon Jacob, Officer in Charge, Sub Regional Office, Coir Board Kolkata, Mr Jogesh Mondal BDO, Mahishadal Development Block, Mr Goutam Sadhu Khan, General Manger, DIC, Mrs Siuli Das, Savapati, Mahishadal Panchayet Samiti, Mr. Tilak Kr. Chakrabarty, Saha Savapati, Mr Tarun Kanti Mondal, Mahisahdal Panchayet Samiti , Mr Abir Sircal, Manager, BGCB, Kapasaria Branch, Mr Madhusudan Maiti, Secretary, KSVSS and other deligates were present in the programme. On the last day one exposure visit to Coir unit at Uluberia, Howrah were organized.

#### ☞ **Road Safety (Save Drive Save Life) :**

To create a safe and secure environment in the roadsides, the society has organized awareness camp and rally on the Kapasaria High Road More (NH -41), Mechada- Haldia Highway to inform the message to the people “SAFE DRIVE – SAVE LIFE”. All the people are aware how to cross the road safely so that they can return to their own home. About 70 youths, women and students participated in the said camp and rally during the year.

#### ☞ **Agriculture & Horticulture:**

A training camp on modern system of agriculture and horticulture was organized by the society with a view to increase the production of agriculture and horticulture products. Different subjects like bio-fertilizer, seed bank, seed collection, seed preservation, application of organic fertilizers etc. were discussed in the camp. The society also distributed seeds and plants of different species of vegetables, fruits & fertilizer, organic medicines among the poor families to promote horticulture production in the local area. Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Purba Medinipur and Asistant Director Office of Agriculture, Mahishadal Block helps us for agriculture and horticulture developments. We helped the farmers to get the Kishan Credit Cards for financial help.

### ☞ Awareness Workshop on Gram Swaraj :

The main objective is to unite backward and distressed people and to promote development of the rural people adopting the Gandhian ideology on Gram Swaraj. Workshop was organized to form Gram Swaraj Sabha in more villages to spread the concept of development spoke by Mahatma Gandhi. Already Gram Swaraj Sabha has been formed in some villages under Mahishadal Block. Gram Swaraj Sabhas are working actively and political influence over the village people is decreased gradually.

### **WELFARE PROGRAMMES:**

#### ☞ Elderly Welfare Programme:

As man comes to the Seattle stage of life sans teeth, sans taste, sans everything and added to no resource is simply an unwanted outskirts of the society. The social, emotional & psychological security and support are essential for their wholesome existence. The society started a day care centre for the elderly people where they come and spend a few times with others for feeling free and to all of them besides him/her.

#### **Celebration of International Day of Disabled Persons :**

We have organized a seminar on International Disability Person day on 03.12.20120 with the help of Itamogra II Gram Panchayet , Mahishadal Panchayet Samiti. We have discussed about their need, their development, different scheme, certification, Manabik Scheme etc. 110 persons were present in this seminar. Besides that, we help them through over the year.

#### **Disaster Management :**

As well as the previous years, this year also, we have organized a training camp on Disaster Management at Mahatma Kutir, Kapasaria, Purba Medinipur. The objective of this programme is to prepare oneself how to save him and others during the disaster like flood, famine, cyclone etc. Resource persons attended and conducted the said training camp on disaster management where 40 youths in the local area undergone the training programme.

#### ☞ During Covid 19 pandemic and Lockdown:

we have given awareness to people by going home to home. We gave soap and mask to every home in our area. We have sanitized near about areas like market, banks, schools, roadside etc. with our volunteers. We gave some relief to poor people during this pandemic.

#### ☞ Cyclone Amphan:

On the day of 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2020 our area faced Super Cyclone Amphan( 200km/h) which destroyed many houses and uprooted trees. During this period we have distributed 30 tarpaulin and 400 plants to beneficiaries with the help of West Bengal Gandhi Peace Foundation, Howrah. We have distributed Carp (Fish) to 20 beneficiaries for their pond.

#### ☞ Memorable Day Celebration:

Our society observed the Birthday of Rabindranath Tagore, Iswar Chandra Vidyasagar, Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, Mahatma Gandhi including Independence day, Republic day, International Women's Day, World AIDS Day, World Environment Day etc. Annual cultural function has also been organized where hundreds of youths, women and children participated. This function includes recitation, songs, dance, drama, etc. which are very useful for entertainment the rural poor people.

#### **CONSUMER PROTECTION PROGRAMME :**

As usual as the previous years, this year also, Kapasaria Sarbik Village Service Society has organized different programme of Consumer Protection activities like Two (2) Assistance Camp on Consumer Protection Act, 1986. Resource Persons from the Dep't. Of Consumer Awareness and Fair Business Practices, Purba Medinipur district, conducted the whole programme. Consumer leaflets, books etc. were distributed among the participants. The Consumer programme has been organized in different place as such as Kapasaria, Bamunia bazar. This programme are sponed by department of Consumer affair and fair business practices purba Medinipur regional office.



### **YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME:**

#### ☞ **“Celebration of Gandhi Jayanti 2020-21” (World Non-Violence & Swachhta Day)**

A Celebration Ceremony was organized on 02.10.2020 at 03-00 p.m. by Nehru Yuba Kendra Sangathan, P.O. Tamluk, Purba Medinipur, West Bengal, Govt. of India in collaboration with Kapasaria Sarbik Village Service Society at Mahatma Kutir, Vill. & P.O. Kapasaria, Dist. Purba Medinipur. Mr Amit Rana, N.Y.S, N.Y.K., Mrs Nabami Gucchait, Member, Itamogra 2 G.P., Mr. Madhusudan Maiti, Secretary, KSVSS attended the camp and share their views on the life of Mahatma Gandhi and World Non-Violence & Swachhta Day. The Resource persons expressed their views on the the lives of the Father of the Nation and importance of celebration of **World Non-Violence & Swachhta Day**. The programme also included Run with youths under **Fit India**, sweeping on the village Road under **Clean India**, rally on the World Non-Violence & Swachhta Day. This programme was participated by 45 nos. of village youths and women.

#### ☞ **RURAL LIBRARY(Gitanjali Granthagar) :**

The rural library namely Gitanjali Granthagar has been maintained by this society at Kapasaria village to increase the reading interest as well as to create a cultural shape among the rural poor people. General public can access the facility of reading as per their choice of time in the afternoon and evening and also take the books. There are 1786 books, different newspapers, magazines etc. Women volunteers are looking after this library efficiently. This year the department of the district Library's, Purba medinipur sanctioned the grant for purpose of books and furniture.

### **IN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION:**

#### ☞ **World Environment Day:**

KSVSS has observed World Environment Day on 5<sup>th</sup> June 2020 at Kapasaria High Road More to aware the public including all the community people about pollution, preventive measures and arrangements to be taken as guard against pollution etc. Environmental experts, panchayat members, and social workers attended this programme. This programme spooned by rotary club of Haldia.

#### ☞ **Observation of Aranya Saptaha :**

To ensure green future for our next generation, our society observed the Aranya Saptaha from at Kapasaria villages 14th July to 20th July, 2020. We have distributed 400 saplings of different species to the villagers and meeting has been organized regarding maintenance of the plants with the help of West Bengal Gandhi Peace Foundation. Mr. Ramkrishna Das, Pradhan Incharge, Itamogra G.P., MR. Biswajit Ghoroi, Social Worker were present along with KSVSS staffs.

### **IN WOMEN EMPOWERMENT:**

#### **Observation of International Women's Day:**

The society has observed the International Women's Day with due respect gathering near about hundreds of women with the supporting of Rotary Club of Haldia. Rural women including SHGs members participated this programme where song, dance and discussion was held on 08.03.2021 women rights, laws against the torturing on women and how to access the facilities of the laws, importance of SHG & income generation for self confidence of women etc.

Mr. Tarun Kanti Mondal, Karmadhaksya, Nari o Jonokalyan, Mahishadal, Panchayet Samiti, Mr Madhusudan Maiti, Secretary, and others volunteers of Kapasaria Sarbik Village Service Society were present in the said programme.

#### ☞ **Self Help Promotional Institute (SHPI)**

The Society has been implementing the Self Help Promotional Institute (SHPI) programme sponsored by NABARD, Govt. of India. The objective of this programme is to improve socio economic status of the rural poor women through involving them in SHGs, small savings, linkage with bank, credit linkage for

providing them credit to undertake entrepreneurship to be self-employed. We are working in Mahishadal block area. At the end of the year 2020-21, 166 Self Help Groups have been formed with bank linkage out of with 143 Self Help Groups have been credit linked. Savings mobilized Rs. 31.3 lakhs, credit provided by the bank (Bangiya Gramin Vikash Bank, Kapasaria Kalyanpur SBI, BGVB, Nandigram)Rs. 290. lakhs. Interlending are also running in the groups. In may be noted that we have not completed our target but we are trying our best.

#### ☞ **Training Programme on Spinning & Weaving of Coir Yarn :**

2 months Training Programme on Spinning & Weaving of Coir Yarn was organized in collaboration with Sub Regional Office, Coir Board, Kolkata, Govt. Of India. 20 women beneficiaries for each of the training got a view to providing skill training towards their self-employment. The said training programme was conducted by the expert trainer and guest faculties. Site Visit and follow up processing were organized also to make the training successful.
