ENDEAVOURS OF K.S.V.S.S.

HEALTH PROGRAMME:

☞ Mother & Child Health Care:

Maternal and Child Health is a package of comprehensive health care services designed to meet the promotive, preventive, curative, and rehabilitative needs of pregnant women before, during, and after delivery, as well as infants and preschool children from birth to five years. KSVSS has organized 2 (two) Mother & Child Health Care Camp in its area during the year. Doctors and other distinguished persons attended the camp and discussed on Health & Hygiene, breast feeding, family planning, infant care, safe maternity, nutrition etc. among the rural women and pregnant mothers to benefit them.

☞ Blood Donation Camp:

The purpose of blood donation camp to select a suitable donor whose blood will be safe to the recipient and who himself shall not in any way be harmed by blood donation. The blood that we donate helps a person in need. It enhances their health condition and makes them overcome their critical situation. In other words, blood donation does not simply help that specific person but also contributes to a responsible gesture towards society. The Society organized a blood donation camp at Mahatma Kutir, Kapasaria on 17.07.2022 where 31 youths and women donated their blood to repay their social debt for the wellbeing of the common people. Dr. Durga Pada Patra, Sk. Rahaman, Karmadhakshya, Mahishadal Panchayat Samity, Mr. Madhusudan Maiti, Secretary, KSVSS and other guests were present in the said programme.

☞ World Disability Day:

The observance of the Day aims to promote an understanding of disability issues and mobilize support for the dignity, rights and well-being of persons with disabilities. KSVSS organized a seminar on International Disability Person Day on 03.12.2022 with the help of Itamogra II Gram Panchayet, Mahishadal Panchayet Samiti. We have discussed about their need, their development, different scheme, certification, Manabik Scheme etc. 46 persons were present in this seminar. Besides that, we help them through over the year.

☞ Dengue Fever & Malaria:

Having a clean and tidy home is extremely important to prevent dengue mosquitoes from infecting you. Smells such as sweat and perfume attract mosquitoes like moths to a flame. Shower often to remove sweat and use perfumes and creams that are unscented. Mosquitoes usually breed in small dark places. The society has arranged awareness camp on 30.09.2022 on Dengue Fever at Kapasaria Sub Health Centre, Kapasaria under Itamogra II Gram Panchayat, Mahishadal Block, Purba Medinipur. **Mr. Tarun Kanti Mondal**, Karmadhakshya, Jana Swasthya, Mahishadal Panchayat Samity, **Mrs. Anuva Das**, Asha karmi, Sub Health Centre, **Mr. Madhusudan Maiti**, Secretary, KSVSS and other dignitaries were present on this programme. 51 persons attended this programme and benefited.

CAMPS & SEMINARS

☞ Water Conservation:

Water conservation is the practice of using water efficiently to reduce unnecessary water usage. According to Fresh Water Watch, water conservation is important because fresh clean water is a limited resource, as well as a costly one. Conserving water saves energy. KSVSS organized awareness camp on water conservation at Kapasaria village in collaboration with Itamogra II Gram Panchayat, Mahishadal Block, Purba Medinipur. Mrs. Sampa Kanp, Pradhan, Itamogra II Gram Panchayat, Mr. Madhusudan Maiti, Secretary, Kapasaria Sarbik Village Service Society attended as resource persons and discussed on the importance of water conservation as well as the preventive measures among the participants.

☞ **Agriculture & Horticulture:**

While agriculture deals with all aspects of crop cultivation, horticulture deals with vegetables, trees, flowers, turf, shrubs, fruits and nuts. A training camp on modern system of agriculture and horticulture was organized by the society with a view to increase the production of agriculture and horticulture products. The SHG women have been included for working under Krishi Bijan Kendra. The society also distributed seeds and plants of different species of vegetables, fruits & fertilizer, organic medicines among the poor families to promote horticulture production in the local area.

☞ **Awareness Workshop on Gram Swaraj:**

Gram Swaraj aims to bring in better transparency and strengthen the e-Governance in Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) across the country through decentralized Profiling, Planning, Physical Progress, Reporting and Work-Based Accounting. Workshop was organized to form Gram Swaraj Sabha in more villages to spread the concept of development spoke by Mahatma Gandhi. Already Gram Swaraj Sabha has been formed in some villages under Mahishadal Block. Gram Swaraj Sabhas are working actively and political influence over the village people is decreased gradually. KSVSS has organized awareness camp / workshop on the ideology of Gandhiji and it was participated by the youths and women.

☞ **Observation of International Women's Day:**

It is a day when women are recognized for their achievements without regard to divisions, whether national, ethnic, linguistic, cultural, economic or political. Since those early years, International Women's Day has assumed a new global dimension for women in developed and developing countries alike. On the day of March 08th, 2023, we organized a seminar on Social and Economic Empowerment of Women on International Women's Day at Mahatma Kutir, Kapasaria, Purba Medinipur. So it was discussed that women's economic empowerment includes women's ability to participate equally in existing markets; their access to and control over productive resources, access to decent work, control over their own time, lives and bodies; and increased voice, agency and meaningful participation in economic decision-making at all levels from the household to international institutions and other things. In this programme 53 persons were present. Mr. Tarun Kanti Mondal, Karmadhaksya, Jana swasthya O Paribesh, Mahishadal Panchayet Samiti, Mr Madhusudan Maiti, Secretary, and others volunteers of Kapasaria Sarbik Village Service Society were present in the said programme.

☞ **Road Safety (Safe Drive Save Life) :**

It provides us with certain rules and regulations that describe how one should use roads diligently and in a proper way. - It also helps in the prevention of accidents and fatality. Proper practice and implementation of road safety rules will reduce accidents, as such accidents are a heavy loss to everyone. Kapasaria High Road More (NH -41), Mechada - Haldia Highway to inform the message to the people "SAFE DRIVE – SAVE LIFE". All the people are aware how to cross the road safely so that they can return to their own home. About 70 youths, women and students participated in the said camp and rally during the year.

☞ **Camp for workers in unorganized Sectors:**

Unorganized workers are deprived from the social security benefits such as- Pensions, Gratuity, Workmen's compensation, Employee State Insurance, deprived from the benefits of the acts of regarding of Regulation of Employment. Workers of the unorganized sector do not have fixed pay, paid leaves, provident funds, payment during holidays, fixed working hours, etc. KSVSS has organized awareness camp with the unorganized workers where discussions held on 12.08.2022 to reach their protest to the government so that the government can enact proper labor laws, fix minimum wages, and provide basic amenities to the unorganized sector workers. This will make their situation better. Pradhan, Itamogra – II G.P. and member of the Mahishadal Panchayat Samity attended and participate in the discussion.

ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME:

☞ World Environment Day:

“Only One Earth” is the campaign slogan of the World Environment Day’ 2022 with the focus on “**Living Sustainably in Harmony with Nature**”. KSVSS has observed World Environment Day on 5th June 2022 at Kapasaria High Road More in collaboration with Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Purba Medinipur to aware the public including all the community people about pollution, preventive measures and arrangements to be taken as guard against pollution etc. Environmental experts, panchayat members, and social workers attended this programme.

☞ Observation of Aranya Saptaha :

Aranya Saptaha Udjapan programme (2022-2023) of R. C. Haldia (District 3291), at Meeting Hall of KSVSS, Kapasaria, Haldia, was organized on 19.07.2022. 35 persons participated in the programme. Social Workers delivered their speeches on the need of plantation towards keeping the environment clean. They also informed that trees will help the people to keep them healthy and save from pollution. Local people appreciated the programme. RCC - Kapasaria Sarbik Village Service Society helped us to organize the programme. Mr. Sanku Maity, Social Activist, Mr. Madhusudan Maiti, Secretary, KSVSS and other guests were present in the said programme.

☞ Awareness Camp on Medicinal Plants :

Medicinal uses of plants can be vast as it helps to cure many diseases like malaria, dengue. Herbs like black pepper, cinnamon, and aloe help to heal wounds like sores and boils. Many herbs are used to purify the blood and reduce fever by eliminating metabolic toxins. Kapasaria Sarbik Village Service Society has organized awareness camp on medicinal plants to sensitize the rural people including women on medicinal plants which we see around us and how it could be used for remedy of various diseases. Mr. Ramkrishna Das, Pradhan In charge, Itamogra G.P., Asha Karmi and social workers were present along with KSVSS staffs. 55 women and youths participated in this camp and benefitted.

CONSUMER PROTECTION PROGRAMME :

As usual as the previous years, this year also, Kapasaria Sarbik Village Service Society has organized different programme of Consumer Protection activities like Two (2) Assistance Camp on Consumer Protection Act, 1986. Different programme on consumer protection like Consumer awareness programme, Seminar, Stall, Banner display programme, Wall writing etc. were organized for different groups of persons Resource Persons from the Dept. of Consumer Awareness and Fair Business Practices, Purba Medinipur district, conducted the whole programme. Consumer leaflets, books etc. were distributed among the participants. Whole programme are sponsored by the department of Consumer affair and fair business practices Purba Medinipur regional office.

INVESTORS AWARENESS PROGRAMME :

With a view to Protecting investors by educating them on their rights and responsibilities. Empowering with knowledge to evaluate different financial products and make informed decisions, enable investors to understand and manage risk, Reduce investors vulnerability to fraudulent schemes. This programme was organized with the help of Angshuman Bhattacharya, Representative of SEBI, Govt. of India. There are Registered Resource Persons who are experienced in education, who conducts investors awareness programmes in different venues in different districts of West Bengal through which investors/ common people were benefitted.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING UNDER COIR BORD, GOI

☞ Skill Development Training under Coir Board :

Skill development programs aim to acknowledge the ability of the youth and extend their support by serving them with the proper guidance, infrastructure, opportunities, and encouragement that help them achieve their ambitions. Education and skills are essential for everyone, and they both walk hand in hand in everyone's career journey. KSVSS conducted 2 months' Skill development training programs on Value Added Products from 22.10.22 to 21.12.2022 & Mahila Coir Yojana 22.11.2022 TO 21.01.2023 at Kapasaria, Purba Medinipur Medinipur sponsored by the Sub-Regional Office, Coir Board, Kolkata. Total 40 (20+20) women have been benefited through these training programmes.

☞ One Day Awareness on Coir Board:

Coir Board is a statutory body established by the Government of India under a legislation enacted by the Parliament namely Coir Industry Act 1953 for the promotion and development of Coir Industry as well as export market of coir and coir products in India as a whole. It is estimated that around 80% of the workforce in the industry are women and it plays a vital role in rural women's empowerment in many coastal districts of the country. With a view to aware the women on the Coir Board, KSVSS conducted one awareness camp on 30.06.2022 Priyadarshini Guest House, Kapasaria, Purba Medinipur on Coir Board in collaboration with the Coir Board.

☞ 2 days Awareness on Human Resource Development Orientation Training Programme on Coir industry :

With a view to ensure that women are provided better opportunities for employment – with emphasis on those living in rural areas and to assist creating products that offer high value to users. To help the industry to enter potential areas. 2 days Awareness on Human Resource Development and orientation training camp was organized by the society among the rural SHG women on and from 20.10.2022 to 21.10.2022 at Priyadarshini Guest House, Kapasaria, Purba Medinipur sponsored by the Sub-Regional Office, Coir Board, Kolkata.

☞ RURAL LIBRARY(Gitanjali Granthagar) :

The rural library namely Gitanjali Granthagar has been maintained by this society at Kapasaria village to increase the reading interest as well as to create a cultural shape among the rural poor people. General public can access the facility of reading as per their choice of time in the afternoon and evening and also take the books. There are about 1810, different newspapers, magazines etc. Women volunteers are looking after this library efficiently. This year the Department of the District Library's, Purba Medinipur kindly sanctioned the grant in aid for purpose of purchasing books and furniture.

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME :

☞ Swachhata Abhijan (NYK):

The concept of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan is to provide basic sanitation facilities like toilets, solid and liquid waste disposal systems, village cleanliness, and safe and adequate drinking water supply to every person. Sanitation and neatness play an important role in our day-to-day routine. It is important as it prevents dangerous diseases like Dengue, typhoid, hepatitis, and other diseases caused by mosquito bite, etc. Now the birthday of Mahatma Gandhi is celebrated as Swachhata Day. KSVSS organized this programme on 02.10.2023 in its premises at Kapasaria, Purba Medinipur in collaboration with Nehru Yuba Kendra, Purba Medinipur. Rural people including youths and women participated this programme to make it successful.

☞ **Gandhi Jayanti:**

Gandhi Jayanti is an Indian holiday marking the 2nd October, birthday of Mahatma Gandhi. The United Nations celebrates the day as International Day of Non-Violence. Called the "Father of The Nation" by Subhas Chandra Bose, Gandhi espoused one of the most well-known philosophies of nonviolent resistance. KSVSS celebrated this holy day in its premises with due respect to our father of the Nation in collaboration with the Nehru Yuba Kendra, Purba Medinipur. Flag hosting, garlanding on the statue, song, discussion of the life of that great man were organized. Youths and women participated in that programme.

☞ **Memorable Day Celebration:**

Our society observed the Birthday of Rabindranath Tagore, Iswar Chandra Vidyasagar, Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, Mahatma Gandhi including Independence Day, Republic Day, International Women's Day, World AIDS Day, World Environment Day etc. Annual cultural function has also been organized where hundreds of youths, women and children participated. This function includes recitation, songs, dance, drama, etc. which are very useful for entertainment the rural poor people.

GITANJALI CULTURAL ACADEMY:

With a view to create a cultural atmosphere in the locality, the society initiated and established Gitanjali Cultural Academy at Kapasaria, Purba Medinipur. Now it is in initial stage, classes on learning song and drawing for the rural children of Mahishadal block area, are being run by the qualified and experienced teachers. During the year 2022-23 role strength of the students of song was and drawing was Already this Centre is now popular to the locality.

SPORTS AND CULTURAL PROGRAMMES:

Sports and culture refer to **the values, customs, and practices associated with sports and physical activity**. It encompasses everything from the way sports are played and watched, to the way they are organized and governed, to the way they are represented in media and popular culture. Throughout the year the society organized different types of cultural programmes. We have organized Sports like volley, football, coaching camp etc. The society also organized Drama show, musical show, folk culture, magic show, recitation, art show etc. for the local youths and children and women.
