ENDEAVOURS OF K.S.V.S.S.

HEALTH PROGRAMME:

Mother & Child Health Care:

A suite of all-inclusive medical treatments called Maternal and Child Health is intended to address the preventative, curative, rehabilitative, and promotive requirements of expectant mothers prior to, during, and following childbirth, as well as those of newborns and young children up to five years old. Throughout the year, KSVSS has hosted two Mother & Child Health Care Camps in the surrounding area. In order to help the rural women and expectant moms, doctors and other notable individuals attended the camp and held discussions on health and hygiene, breastfeeding, family planning, infant care, safe maternity, nutrition, etc. Dr. Debopam Hazra, MBBS & Dr. Mohanlal Ghorai, MBBS were present for health checkup of children and mothers.

World Disability Day:

The purpose of the Day's observance is to raise awareness of disability issues and rally support for the worth, rights, and welfare of people with disabilities. With the assistance of Itamogra II Gram Panchayet, KSVSS arranged a seminar on International Disability Day on December 3, 2023. We have talked about their requirements, growth, various schemes, accreditation, Manabik Scheme, and so forth. There were forty-six attendees at this seminar. Aside from that, we support them all year long. Dr. Mohanlal Ghorai, MBBS, M.O., Basulia Rural Hospital, Mr. Ramkrishna Das, Pradhan, Itamogra II Gram Panchayet, Mr. Prasenjit Maity, Member, Itamogra II Gram Panchayet, Mr. Madhusudan Maiti, Secretary, KSVSS, were present in this seminar and delivered their speeches.

Thalassemia Awareness Camp:

International Thalassemia Day serves as a crucial platform to emphasize the importance of disease prevention, raise awareness, sensitize stakeholders, promote early detection, and ensure quality care for those affected by thalassemia. Importance of this programme is (i) Educating people about the causes and symptoms of thalassemia and the prevention of it, (ii) Raising awareness about the challenges and needs of the people suffering from thalassemia, and (iii) Providing economic support to the patients and their families in dealing with the disorder. On May 05, 2023, the Society hosted awareness camp at Mahatma Kutir, Kapasaria, where 33 young people and women gave their blood in order to make up for their social obligation and support the welfare of the general public.

Cancer Awareness Camp:

Prevention is about understanding the causes of cancer, assessing cancer risk where possible and mitigating against the risks. Early detection relies on the ability to identify cancer in its infancy or in a pre-cancerous state, before the disease has spread and while it is still relatively easy to treat. Objective of this programme is increasing cancer awareness in more deprived areas could help to reduce health inequalities and improve cancer outcomes and having cancer awareness will give you the confidence to speak to a doctor if something doesn't feel normal to you, as spotting cancer early increases the chance of survival. **Dr. Mohanlal Ghorai, MBBS** and **Mr. Basudev Mondal**, Member, Rotary Club, Haldia were present in the said camp.

Dengue Fever & Malaria:

To address this growing problem, the National Dengue Prevention and Control Program was established in 1993. The program consists of case and vector surveillance, case diagnosis and management, integrated vector management, outbreak response, health promotion and advocacy, and research. The society has arranged awareness camp on 30.09.2023 on Dengue Fever at Kapasaria Sub Health Centre, Kapasaria under Itamogra II Gram Panchayet, Mahishadal Block, Purba Medinipur., **Mr. Uday Narayan Sahoo**, Member, Rotary Club of Haldia, **Dr. Saruk Azad, BMOH**, Basulia Rural Hospital, **Mr. Ramkrishna Das**, Pradhan, Itamogra II G.P., **Mrs. Nirupama Samanta**, **Manika Mishra & Mrs. Anuva Das**, Asha Karmies, Sub Health Centre, **Mr. Madhusudan Maiti**, Secretary, KSVSS and other dignitaries were present on this programme. 51 persons attended this programme and benefited.

CAMPS & SEMINARS

Independence Day Celebration:

Independence Day marks the end of British rule in 1947, brought about by the Indian Independence Act of July 18 that year, and the establishment of a free and independent Indian nation. Independence is an essential aspect of human life that can be described as the ability to take care of oneself and make decisions without relying on others. Being independent is important for various reasons, ranging from personal growth and development to financial stability and self-sufficiency. The Society organized this programme where different honorable guests and reputed persons in the locality attended the programme and remembered the sacrifices of the great leaders and general people to achieve the independence of our country.

Swami Vivekananda's Birthday :

Swami Vivekananda's Birthday is celebrated on January 12 and is also known as Rashtriya Yuva Diwas. Rashtriya Yuva Diwas, commonly known as National Youth Day, is observed on Swami Vivekananda's birth anniversary. The day is observed to commemorate the birthday of Swami Vivekananda, one of India's most influential leaders. This national event honors the country's youth and encourages them to embrace Vivekananda's ideas and philosophies. The society organized this programme with great enthusiasm and hundreds of youths and women participated this programme.

Observation of Memorable Days :

Our society observed the Birthday of Rabindranath Tagore, Iswar Chandra Vidyasagar, Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, Mahatma Gandhi including Independence Day, Republic Day, International Women's Day, World Environment Day etc. Annual Cultural function has also been organized where hundreds of youths, women and children participated. This function includes recitation, songs, dance, drama, etc. which are very useful for entertainment the rural poor people.

Shaheed Diwas Palan:

Mahatma Gandhi is fondly called "Bapu". January 30th marks the death anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi - the father of the nation - who was assassinated on this day by Nathuram Godse in 1948. Mahatma Gandhi, who is fondly called "Bapu" in India, played a vital role in India's freedom movement. This day is observed as Martyrs' Day, also known as Shaheed Diwas, is observed on January 30th each year in India to pay homage to the brave souls who sacrificed their lives for the freedom and welfare of the nation. This day holds immense historical importance, symbolizing the spirit of sacrifice and the relentless struggle for independence. KSVSS has observed this day where ideology of Gandhiji was discussed by the different reputed persons among the youths and women.

International Women's Day Celebration:

The campaign theme for International Women's Day 2024 was Inspire Inclusion. When we inspire others to understand and value women's inclusion, we forge a better world. Since those early years, International Women's Day has assumed a new global dimension for women in developed and developing countries alike. On the day of March 08th, 2024, International Women's Day, we celebrate women and girls, and we applaud all they have achieved in the fight for equality. Women and girls have made great gains – demolishing barriers, dismantling stereotypes and driving progress towards a more just and equal world. This programme was held at Priyadarshini Guest House, Kapasaria, where 150 women were present. ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME:

World Environment Day & Environment Awareness Camp:

World Environment Day is the largest global platform for environmental public outreach and is celebrated by millions of people across the world. It's a day to learn about the environment, participate in conservation activities, and learn about ways to help in the future. To celebrate at school, you can commune with nature, create new environmental programs, use nature-centered lesson plans, and work on earth-centered activities. KSVSS has observed World Environment Day on 5th June 2023 at Kapasaria High Road More in collaboration with Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Purba Medinipur to aware the public including all the community people about pollution, preventive measures and arrangements to be taken as guard against pollution etc. Environmental experts, panchayat members, and social workers attended this programme.

Awareness Camp on Medicinal Plants :

Medicinal uses of plants can be vast as it helps to cure many diseases like malaria, dengue. Medicinal plants like aloe, turmeric, tulsi, pepper, elaichi and ginger are commonly used in a number of Ayurvedic home remedies and are considered to be the best aid among fighting ailments related to throat and skin. Many herbs are used to purify the blood and reduce fever by eliminating metabolic toxins. Kapasaria Sarbik Village Service Society has organized awareness camp on medicinal plants to sensitize the rural people including women on medicinal plants which we see around us and how it could be used for remedy of various diseases. Mr. Ramkrishna Das, Pradhan In charge, Itamogra II G.P., Asha Karmi and social workers were present along with KSVSS staffs. 55 women and youths participated in this camp and benefitted.

Aranya Saptaha Udjapan :

Aranya Saptaha Udjapan programme (2023-24) in collaboration with the Rotary Club, Haldia (District 3291), at Meeting Hall of KSVSS, Kapasaria, Haldia, was organized on 19.07.2022. 35 persons participated in the programme. Social Workers delivered their speeches on the need of plantation towards keeping the environment clean. They also informed that trees will help the people to keep them healthy and save from pollution. Plantation of saplings were also held on the two sides of the village road. Saplings were also distributed to the poor and backward families to earn a supplementary income of the family. CONSUMER PROTECTION PROGRAMME :

As usual as the previous years, this year also, Kapasaria Sarbik Village Service Society has organized different programme of Consumer Protection activities like Assistance Camps on Consumer Protection Act, 1986. Different programme on consumer protection like (i) Banner Display for Consumer Awareness at Rabindra Najrul Jayanti and Durga Puja (ii) Seminar with SHG Women at village Kapasaria, Bamunia, Kasthakhali, Anandapur, Kakhurda Tatharibar, Jhaupathra & Champi (iii) Consumer Awareness Camp, (iv) Seminars with School Students at Barsundra High School, Champi High School, Harikhali High School, Dakshin Kashimnagar High School, and Keshab Jalpai High School (v) Stall for Consumer Awareness at Durga Puja, Rath Mela, were organized for different groups of persons. Resource Persons from the Dept. of Consumer Awareness and Fair Business Practices, Purba Medinipur district, conducted the whole programme. Consumer leaflets, books etc. were distributed among the participants. Whole programme are sponsored by the department of Consumer affair and fair business practices Purba Medinipur regional office.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING UNDER COIR BORD, GOI

Field Training under Coir Board :

Skill development programs aim to acknowledge the ability of the youth and extend their support by serving them with the proper guidance, infrastructure, opportunities, and encouragement that help them achieve their ambitions. Education and skills are essential for everyone, and they both walk hand in hand in everyone's career journey. KSVSS is conducting a number of Field Training Centers as per the convenience of coir workers. The Field Training Centers run with the help of NGOs engaged in coir activities at Kapasaria, Purba Medinipur Medinipur sponsored by the Sub-Regional Office, Coir Board, Kolkata. Total 40 (20+20) women have been benefited through these training programmes.

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME :

Gandhi Janma Jayanti:

Gandhi Jayanti is an Indian holiday marking the 2nd October, birthday of Mahatma Gandhi. The United Nations celebrates the day as International Day of Non-Violence. Called the "Father of The Nation" by Subhas Chandra Bose, Gandhi espoused one of the most well-known philosophies of nonviolent resistance. KSVSS celebrated this holy day in its premises with due respect to our father of the Nation in collaboration with the Itamogra II Gram Panchayat. Flag hosting, garlanding on the statue, song, discussion of the life of that great man were organized. Local area were also cleaned by the participants towards swachh bharat. Youths and women participated in that programme. Mr. Ramkrishna Das, Pradhan, Itamogra II Gram Panchayat, Dr. Modit Saxena, Principal, Jawhar Nabodaya Vidyalaya, Mr. Kalyan Sundar Das, Teacher, Barsundra High School, Mr. Prasenjit Maity, Member, Itamogra II Gram Panchayat and Mr. Madhusudan Maiti, Secretary KSVSS were present in this occasion.

GITABITAN CULTURAL ACADEMY:

With a view to create a cultural atmosphere in the locality, the society initiated and established Gitanjali Cultural Academy at Kapasaria, Purba Medinipur. Classes on learning song and drawing for the rural children of Mahishadal block area, are being run by the qualified and experienced teachers. During the year 2023-24 role strength of the students of song was 18 and drawing was 26. Already this Centre is now popular to the locality.

SPORTS AND CULTURAL PROGRAMMES:

Sports and culture refer to the values, customs, and practices associated with sports and physical activity. It encompasses everything from the way sports are played and watched, to the way they are organized and governed, to the way they are represented in media and popular culture. During the year 2023-24, the society organized different types of cultural programmes.

Songs & Drama Show :

Music and cultural festivals throughout history have been known to be key ingredients of promoting socio-cultural integration among various communities. Art, dance, and drama can have many benefits for human development. These activities can promote creativity and self-expression, improve cognitive skills such as problem-solving and critical thinking, and enhance emotional intelligence and social skills. Every year the society organizes this programme and it is participated by the youths and women with great enthusiasm. Now this programme is very popular in the locality.

Yogasan Camp :

Scalar yoga retreat or yoga camp is an excellent choice to try and stop for a moment, to get away from the stresses of everyday life and bring back peace and natural wisdom, with the guidance of an experienced yoga Teacher. Yoga Camps for Kids empowers them through pranayama (breathing techniques) to improve focus and concentration and calms their nervous system. The society organized Yoga Camp at Kapasaria in the month of January 2024 and 40 youths and children participated in this camp and benefitted.

Sports Competition & Coaching :

As usual as the previous years, this year also Kapasaria Sarbik Village Service Society hosted Sports competition programme where children, youths and women participated in different types of athletic games like run, potato race, high jump, long jump, musical chair, skipping, swimming etc. At the end of the sports competition a closing ceremony was held where the successful participants were handed over prizes by the respectable guests and Govt. officials. Local people enjoyed the whole programme very much.

RURAL LIBRARY(Gitanjali Granthagar) :

The rural library namely Gitanjali Granthagar has been maintained by this society at Kapasaria village to increase the reading interest as well as to create a cultural shape among the rural poor people. General public can access the facility of reading as per their choice of time in the afternoon and evening and also take the books. There are about 1810, different newspapers, magazines etc. Women volunteers are looking after this library efficiently.
